Details regarding Admission Procedure for MBA (Agribusiness)

1. Short listing Criteria: For short listing the candidates for MBA (Agri-Business) admissions, 70% weightage will be given to the valid score/certificate of CUCET/CAT/GMAT tests, 10% for the Diversity Factor (DF), 5% for Statement of Purpose and 10% for Personal Interview (PI).

The candidates seeking admission through CAT/GMAT score must have a score of ≥ 80 percentile in CAT or ≥ 80 percent in GMAT entrance test and will only be eligible for admission and given full weightage of 70 percent out of 100 percent. Candidates of CAT/GMAT with a score below than above mentioned score will be ineligible to apply.

- 2. For the candidates seeking admission to MBA (Agri-Business) either through CUCET or CAT/GMAT examinations there will be Personal Interview (PI) instead of online counselling.
- 3. The candidates qualifying for admission to MBA (Agri-Business) Programme through CAT/GMAT shall have to submit their application in the prescribed application form along with requisite fee of Rs.750/- and self-attested copy of certificates and testimonials. Application form is to be downloaded from the University website.
- 4. Candidates seeking admission through CAT/GMAT examination have to deposit application fee of Rs.750/- in the University account through NEFT along with the duly filled application form. Bank details are as follows:

5. The scanned copy of the duly filled application form along with self-attested copy of certificates, testimonials and the receipt of payment made to the University through NEFT is to be submitted through e-Mail. Candidates have to submit a hard copy of the filled application along with the original receipt of payment made through NEFT, by Speed-Post/Registered-Post or in person to the office of the Controller of Examinations of the University on or before the due date.

- 6. Out of total 15 seats, 1/3rd of the seats (5 seats) shall be kept for the candidates seeking admission to MBA (Agribusiness) through CAT/GMAT. In case of non-availability of such suitable candidates, these seats will automatically be transferred to the CUCET pool.
- 7. For 15 seats, 90 candidates (qualifying for admission through CUCET/CAT/GMAT) in all, out of which 30 candidates with eligibility through CAT/GMAT be called for Personal Interview.
- 8. Schedule of Application submission, Personal Interview and Admission to the Programme shall be as follows:
 - Last Date for submission of the application along with application fee along with selfattested copy of certificates and testimonials for the candidates qualified for admission to MBA (Agri-Business) Programme through CAT/GMAT examination: 14th June, 2017

Note:

- (a) If number of candidates applying through CAT/GMAT is more than 30, the top 30 candidates (w.r.t. CAT/GMAT score) are to be called for the personal interview.
- (b) The candidates shortlisted for Personal Interview are to be intimated through e-Mail as well as by uploading the information on the University website on 19th June, 2017
- **(c)** On the university website advise for the candidates be loaded for keeping a regular track regarding admissions to MBA (Agri-Business) Programme.
- ii. Date of Personal Interview: 4th and 5th July, 2017
- iii. Selected and waitlisted candidates to be finalized and uploaded on the University website by 10th of July, 2017. The selected candidates will be intimated through e-Mail.
- iv. The selected candidates will have to pay the fees on or before 17th July, 2017
- v. Un-filled seats are to be offered to the waitlisted candidates on **19**th **July, 2017** and they will be given 5 working days to pay their fees.
- vi. For any unfilled seat there-after, the same procedure will be followed upto 3 weeks after start of the classes.
- 9. The orientation of the selected candidates shall be carried out on **21**st **July**, **2017** and the classes shall commence from **24**th **of July**, **2017**.
- 10. The attendance of every student admitted to the Programme shall be watched and in case of his/her absence from the classes for one week continuously, without prior intimation to the concerned authority, his/ her seat will be declared vacant and such vacated seat(s) shall be offered to the waitlisted candidates and the procedure detailed above shall be followed to fill the seat.
- 11. The Reservation/Relaxation will be given as per Government of India/University Rules as adopted by the University time to time.
- 12. Schedule of activities mentioned above may be changed at any time due to administrative reasons.
